RE: Docket No. 030448-WS - Disposition of delinquent regulatory assessment fees for Meadows Utility Company, Inc. in Citrus County.

ISSUE 1: Should Meadows Utility Company, Inc. be ordered to show cause, in writing, within 21 days why it should not be fined for failure to remit its regulatory assessment fees as required by Section 367.145, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.120, Florida Administrative Code?

RECOMMENDATION: No. A show cause proceeding should not be initiated. Staff further recommends that the Commission refer the utility's unpaid regulatory assessment fees (RAFs) and associated penalties and interest to the Department of Financial Services for permission to write off the accounts as uncollectible.


