Dear Mr. Tubolino:

Following up a customer billing complaint, staff has discovered that the utility has added a \$10 late payment charge to its bill. This charge is not contained in the utility's tariffs on file with the Commission. Section 367.091(4), Florida Statutes, specifies that a utility may only impose and collect those rates and charges approved by the Commission for the particular class of service involved. Because this charge has not been approved by the Commission, the utility should immediately remove this charge from its bills. Further, the utility should refund any late payment charges collected. If the utility would like staff to include a late payment charge as part of the above referenced docket, please provide staff with cost justification for a late payment charge. In the past, the Commission has approved late payment charges ranging from \$3 to \$5. The Commission has only approved these charges to recover the additional cost associated with a late payment charge. Additional cost would include, postage, copying, and employee time to process late payment. If you have any questions regarding this matter, please contact Mr. Ryan Fitch at (850)-413-6928.
