ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION BY DEBTOR TO EMPLOY GRONEK & LATHAM, LLP, NUNC PRO TUNC TO JULY 16, 2003, AND FOR AUTHORITY TO PAY \$35,000 RETAINER AND AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL OF JAMES E. FOSTER AND AKERMAN SENTERFITTT, AS DEBTOR'S COUNSEL

THIS CASE came on for hearing on August 7, 2003 (the "Hearing"), upon the application by Advanced Telecommunication Network, Inc. (the "Debtor"), to employ R. Scott Shuker, attorney, and the law firm of Gronek & Latham, LLP ("G&L"), as Debtor's counsel in this case (the "Application") and the Verified Statement in Support of Application to Employ Gronek & Latham, LLP, as counsel. Upon consideration of the Application, and having heard from counsel for all interested parties present at the Hearing, the Court finds that it is in the best interests of the estate to allow the Application as set forth below.

Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED:

1. In accordance with Section 327 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtor is authorized to employ R. Scott Shuker and the law-

firm of Gronek & Latham, LLP, as counsel in this case, *nunc pro tunc* to July 16, 2002.

2. The Debtor is authorized to disburse \$35,000 to G&L as a retainer against which G&L can bill, subject to review and approval by this Court upon proper application in accordance with 11 U.S.C. § 330.

3. During the pendency of the case, any unearned retainer shall be held in a trust account.

4. Until further order of the Court, G&L may bill against the retainer on a monthly basis for 100% of its costs and for 70% of its fees as they accrue without further order, but subject to final review and approval by the Court.

5. This Order is without prejudice to G&L requesting, by subsequent application or motion, additional payment of fees and expenses.

6. James E. Foster and Aakerman Senterfitt are hereby relieved of any further responsibility in this case.
