Upon further review, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") has determined that a few revisions to Exhibit C are necessary. Accordingly, FPL submits herewith an Amended Exhibit C, the Justification Table. Amended Exhibit C removes references to WP 43-9 consisting of 36 pages which were returned to FPL by the Audit Staff. The table also has been revised to clearly indicate FPL is not requesting confidential classification for the following documents: WP 16-2/1-1/1, WP 16-2/1-2/2, WP 43-11 page 1, WP 43-11 page 2, WP 43-11 page 3, WP 43-11/1, WP 43-15, and WP 43-15/1.

In addition, FPL is furnishing herewith the amended affidavit of Dennis Brandt, which supports FPL's request for confidential classification of customer account information. As reflected in the Amended Affidavit of Mr. Brandt submitted as Exhibit D, nothing has changed since the issuance of the Commission's Order No. PSC 01-2249-CFO-EG that would alter the confidential nature of the information. FPL requests that the information be protected as confidential as it remains in the files of the Commission. ) **AFFIDAVIT OF DENNIS BRANDT**

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Dennis Brandt who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. My name is Dennis Brandt. I am currently employed by Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"). My title is Director, Product Development and Management. I have personal knowledge of the matters stated in this affidavit.

2. Regarding FPL's Exhibit C, I have reviewed the documents and information for which I am listed as Affiant and which are included in Exhibit B to FPL's Request for Confidential Classification. Such documents or materials that I have reviewed and which, in whole or in part, are asserted by FPL to be proprietary confidential business information, as noted on Exhibit C, contain or constitute customer-specific account information or information relating to same with respect to non-governmental customers. On November 16, 2001, the Commission granted confidential classification for the information redacted from WP44-1/1-1/3 series (34 Pages) because specific customer names are associated with specific usage information and account numbers.¹ Nothing has changed since the issuance of the Commission's Order No. PSC 01-2249-CFO-EG that would alter the confidential nature of the information.


3. FPL continues to treat the information as confidential consistent with FPL's policy not to disclose customer-specific information without the consent of the customer. Customer usage and patterns may not vary significantly from year to year. Thus, disclosure of a prior year's data may afford competitors an unfair advantage insofar as they may be able to deduce certain characteristics of the customer's operations, output, demand, or business cycle based on electric usage or consumption patterns with respect to current or future operations. The fact that an individual account may have become inactive does not necessarily render the information non-competitively sensitive. Often businesses have multiple accounts one or more of which may become inactive as business locations change. Nevertheless, the information from an inactive account could still be used to infer competitive data regarding the customer's other

locations. FPL does not release the information of a single inactive account because it does not track and cannot say whether an account is part of a multi-site operation or business. Further, the fact that an account number shows up as "inactive" in FPL's records does not mean that the business has ceased operations. A business that has relocated or come under new ownership will receive a new account number and will continue to have an interest in continued confidentiality of the information pertaining to the prior account number. FPL believes that its customers have a continued right and expectation regarding the privacy of their information. FPL has maintained the confidentiality of this information and does not disclose such information to third parties unless required by law or unless the customer or vendor consents to such disclosure.


4. In order to protect the confidential status of customer-specific information, FPL seeks confidential classification of the names of customers, and account numbers on the materials in question. FPL believes that the Commission should support this policy by continuing to maintain the information as confidential for as long as the Commission retains the information.
