for Expedited Review of Growth Code Denials by NeuStar for the Tampa Central Rate

Center.

On August 27, 2003, Time Warner filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision to deny numbering resources in the Tampa Central rate center. Specifically, Time Warner requested two (2) 1,000 number blocks in order to meet the customer's request for 1,500 sequential numbers. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL which approved an expedited process for code denials, we have examined the Time Warner petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a specific customer in need of immediate numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to the potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of numbering resources; and
- The potential customers cannot obtain service from the provider of its choice because the carrier does not have numbers available to fulfill the customers' needs.

Since the three required criteria of Order PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (September 18, 2003) as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide Time Warner the numbering resources to meet its customer's needs, specifically, two (2) 1,000 consecutive number blocks in order to meet the customer's request for 1,500 sequential numbers in the Tampa Central rate center. Please be sure that in the Order, NeuStar is directed to provide the numbers, not NANPA. Also, please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued.
