
Dear Clint:

In accordance with our telephone conference last week, enclosed is First Revised Sheet No. 22.0 of the Utilities, Inc. of Florida Wastewater Tariff - Seminole County reflecting the increase in service availability charges for those persons connecting to the Ravena Park/Lincoln Heights wastewater service area of UIF. Since UIF uses independent contractors for tap-ins, I have included the tap-in charge as the actual cost incurred by UIF for that service.
