

PRELIMINARY ISSUES

Generic Energy Conservation Cost Recovery Issues

ISSUE 1: What is the final end-of-the-period true-up amount for the period January 2002 through December 2002?


FIPUG: FIPUG has no position at this time, but reserves the right to take a position on this issue by the date of the prehearing conference.

ISSUE 2: What are the appropriate conservation cost recovery factors by customer class for the period January 2004 through December 2004?

FIPUG: FIPUG has no position at this time, but reserves the right to take a position on this issue by the date of the prehearing conference.

ISSUE 3: What should be the effective date of the energy conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

FIPUG: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2004 through December 2004. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2004, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2004, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.

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
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
