By this letter the Commission staff acknowledges that we have received the above-noted application, however, the filing does not comply with Rule 25-30.565, Florida Administrative Code. The utility filed the application pursuant to Section 367.091(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-9.004, F.A.C. to amend its tariff to increase meter installation fees. However, the application should have been filed in accordance with Rule 25-30.565, F.A.C. Specifically, Rule 25-9.004 addresses the procedures for filing and construction of tariffs, whereas Rule 25-30.565 specifically addresses the requirements for approval of modification of existing service availability charges.

Further, staff requests that O&S Water Company, Inc. (O&S) provide responses to the following data requests:

- 1. Is O&S going to perform the installation of the meters? Is O&S going to perform the installation of the backflow prevention devices?
- 2. If so, does O&S intend to purchase the meters and/or backflow prevention devices in bulk quantity?
- 4. Did O&S obtain bids for the meter purchase? Were bids obtained for the backflow prevention devices?
  5. If so, please provide a copy of each bid.
  6. Please provide a separate breakdown to support the cost of installation of the each meter 3. Does O&S require a backflow prevention device to be installed with the installation of

and backflow prevention device (include copies of any supporting documentation).

- 7. Does O&S intend to replace any of its current water meters with new meters?
- 8. What are ERT's? (Referenced on Exhibit "A" in the application)

It will be necessary for you to file the required information as outlined in Rule 25-30.565, F.A.C. and respond to the questions listed above. In order for us to process this application, these filing requirements and information should reach us by November 17, 2003.
