Dear Ms. Atkisson:

This is a follow up to our telephone conversation on Friday, September 26, 2003.

Concerning the IXC (TJ342), a recommendation was filed on September 25, 2003, to fine the company \$500 for nonpayment of the 2002 fee, and the Commissioners are scheduled to vote on Docket No. 030775-TI at the October 7<sup>th</sup> Agenda Conference. After the vote, the attorney assigned to the case is scheduled to issue an Order by October 27<sup>th</sup> (the Order can be issued any time between the date of the vote on October 7<sup>th</sup> and October 27<sup>th</sup>) based on the Commissioners' vote. The company will then have 20 days to protest the Order by proposing a settlement or requesting cancellation of its tariff and removal from the Register.

Attached is the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee return form, which needs to be completed and returned with payment, including the statutory penalty and interest charges. Also attached is a copy of Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, which deals with filing petitions (protests).

If the company does not wish to keep its registration active, it should request cancellation of its tariff and request its name be removed from the register. The company should pay the \$3.00 penalty and interest charges for late payment of the 2000 Regulatory Assessment Fee, the 2002 Regulatory Assessment Fee, including penalty and interest charges, and the 2003 Regulatory Assessment Fee. The 2002 return form is attached. If the company needs the 2003 return form, let me know and I'll fax it also.

If the company wishes to keep its certificate active, the company should propose a settlement. Any settlement should then contain the following elements:

- 1) Docket number;
- 2) A check for the past due amount in full. (It should be noted that just paying the past due amount will not prevent the company's tariff from being cancelled and its name removed from the register);
- 3) A statement that the company has taken steps to prevent future late payments of the Regulatory Assessment Fees and what those steps are;
- 4) A waiver of objection, which should state: The company agrees to waive any objection to the administrative cancellation of its certificate should it fail to pay in accordance with its settlement offer. If, however, there is a factual dispute as to the manner or level of compliance with any provision in the settlement, Commission staff will bring the matter to the Commission for consideration; and
- 5) Make a specific monetary settlement. There is normally a \$500 fine for this rule violation. However, the Commission has accepted amounts less than the fine amount in other similar cases.

Any settlement offer/correspondence should be addressed to Ms. Blanca Bayó, Director, Division of the Commission Clerk & Administrative Services, Florida Public Service Commission, 2540 Shumard Oak Blvd., Tallahassee, FL 32399-0850. The proposed settlement amount should **not** be paid at the time the settlement is mailed. The settlement amount, if approved by the Commission, must be paid within 14 calendar days after the Commission Order is issued.

## PART II HEARINGS INVOLVING DISPUTED ISSUES OF MATERIAL FACT

### 28-106.201 Initiation of Proceedings.

(1) Unless otherwise provided by statute, initiation of proceedings shall be made by written petition to the agency responsible for rendering final agency action. The term "petition" includes any document that requests an evidentiary proceeding and asserts the existence of a disputed issue of material fact. Each petition shall be legible and on 8 ½ by 11 inch white paper. Unless printed, the impression shall be on one side of the paper only and lines shall be double-spaced.

(2) All petitions filed under these rules shall contain:

(a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;

(b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination;

(c) A statement of when and how the petitioner received notice of the agency decision;

(d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;

(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action;

(f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

(3) Upon receipt of a petition involving disputed issues of material fact, the agency shall grant or deny the petition, and if granted shall, unless otherwise provided by law, refer the matter to the Division of Administrative Hearings with a request that an administrative law judge be assigned to conduct the hearing. The request shall be accompanied by a copy of the petition and a copy of the notice of agency action.

(4) A petition shall be dismissed if it is not in substantial compliance with subsection (2) of this rule or it has been untimely filed. Dismissal of a petition shall, at least once, be without prejudice to petitioner's filing a timely amended petition curing the defect, unless it conclusively appears from the face of the petition that the defect cannot be cured.

(5) The agency shall promptly give written notice to all parties of the action taken on the petition, shall state with particularity its reasons if the petition is not granted, and shall state the deadline for filing an amended petition if applicable.

- (2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request.
- (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.
  - (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.
- (3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).

#### **25-24.474 Cancellation of a Certificate.**

(1) The Commission may on its own motion cancel a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:

- (a) Violation of the terms and conditions under which the authority was originally granted;
- (b) Violation of Commission rule or order; or
- (c) Violation of Florida Statutes.

(2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request.

- (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.
- (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.
- (c) A statement on treatment of customer deposits and final bills.
- (d) Proof of individual customer notice regarding discontinuance of service.

(3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).
