COMMISSIONER BAEZ: All right. We'll call the hearing to order. Counsel, can you read the notice.

MS. FLEMING: Pursuant to notice issued by the clerk of the Commission on September 24th, 2003, this time and place has been set for a prehearing in Docket Numbers 030001-EI. 030002-EG, 030003-GU, 030004-GU, 030007-EI.

COMMISSIONER BAEZ: All right. And we're going to take appearances. And, as you can see, we've got, by my count, five dockets. So if you would kindly enter your appearance and declare the dockets that you're entering an appearance for.

Mr. Beasley, we can start with you.

MR. BEASLEY: Yes, sir, Commissioner. I'm James D. Beasley appearing with Lee L. Willis and Kenneth R. Hart from the law firm of Ausley & McMullen in Tallahassee, and we're representing Tampa Electric Company in Docket Numbers 030001, 12 and 7.

MR. BADDERS: Good morning. I'm Russell Badders. I'm appearing on behalf of Gulf Power Company in the 01, 02 and 07 dockets.

MR. PERKO: Good morning. I'm Gary Perko of the Hopping, Green & Sams Law Firm. I'm appearing on behalf of City Gas Company of Florida in the 03 and 04 dockets, and Progress Energy Florida in the 07 docket.

1	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Thank you.
2	MR. SCHIEFELBEIN: Good morning. Wayne Schiefelbein,
3	Rose, Sundstrom & Bentley, appearing on behalf of the Florida
4	Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation in the 04 docket.
5	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Is there anyone else that needs
6	to enter an appearance?
7	MR. TWOMEY: Ron, you need to use a mike so the court
8	reporter can hear you.
9	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Can you step up I'm sorry, Mr.
10	Twomey. Can you step up to a microphone, Mr. Rogers.
11	MR. LAFACE: I'm sorry. Ron LaFace and John Rogers
12	appearing for the Florida Retail Federation in the 01, 02 and
13	07 (sic.) docket.
14	MR. GUYTON: Charles Guyton and John Butler with the
15	law firm of Steel, Hector & Davis, appearing on behalf of
16	Florida Power & Light Company. I'm appearing in the 02 docket.
17	Mr. Butler is appearing in the 01 and the 07 dockets.
18	MR. TWOMEY: Good morning, Commissioner. Mike
19	Twomey, Post Office Box 5256, Tallahassee 32314-5256, appearing
20	in the 01 docket on behalf of Katherine Claypool and
21	eight other residential ratepayers of TECO Electric.
22	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Is that everybody? Mike, we
23	don't have anyone participating on the phone that you know of?
24	Okay. Great. All right.
25	MR. KEATING: We do need to enter appearances for the

1	staff counsel.
2	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: I'm sorry. After so many of them
3	today.
4	MR. KEATING: Cochran Keating on behalf of the
5	Commission in Docket 01.
6	MS. FLEMING: Katherine Echternacht-Fleming on behalf
7	of the Commission in Docket 03.
8	MS. HOLLEY: Lorena Holley on behalf of the
9	Commission for Dockets 02 and 04.
10	MS. STERN: Marlene Stern and Adrienne Vining on
11	behalf of the Commission in Docket 07.
12	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: All right. Just a quick, a quick
13	note here for all the parties. We're going to try and follow
14	some order and get certain dockets out of the way first.
15	We're going to be following the following order:
16	It's 03, 04, 02, 07 and 01. We'll see if we can get some of
17	you all out on time.
18	Counsel, we need to address some excusals, I believe.
19	MS. FLEMING: Yes. That is correct. St. Joe Natura
20	Gas Company has requested to be excused from the prehearing and
21	hearing in the 03 and 04 dockets.
22	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: All right. Let the record
23	reflect that St. Joe Natural Gas has been excused from the
24	prehearing conference and the hearing in the 03 and 04 dockets.

COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Moving on. Excuse me. We're on 1 2 the 02 docket. Again, any changes to the order of witnesses? MS. HOLLEY: Not to the order. But pursuant to a 3 4 recent proposed stipulation with FPUC, Michael A. Peacock 5 should be shown with an asterisk next to his name for possible 6 excusal. 7 COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Okay. Thank you. 8 Now that only leaves Mr. Lacaci. 9 MS. HOLLEY: Actually he should not be on there. 10 COMMISSIONER BAEZ: He shouldn't even be on there. MS. HOLLEY: No. No. sir. 11 COMMISSIONER BAEZ: All right. We'll strike 12 13 Mr. Lacaci from the list of witnesses. To the basic positions, and, again, I'm going in 14 order of the draft that I have before me. So, Ms. Kaufman, do 15 16 you have any changes to the basic or on the issues that you need to make at this point? 17 MS. KAUFMAN: Commissioner Baez, no, FIPUG is going 18 19 to take no position on these issues. Thank you. 20 COMMISSIONER BAEZ: No position. Okay. Thank you. Florida Power & Light. 21 22 MR. GUYTON: No changes. 23 COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Mr. Horton, FPUC. 24 MR. HORTON: Yes, sir. We do have some changes to 25 Issue 2 and 5.

1	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: All right. Issue 2.
2	MR. HORTON: It's on my Page 7, Commissioner.
3	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: I have it.
4	MR. HORTON: The consolidated number should be
5	.00054.
6	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: 54, you say?
7	MR. HORTON: Yes, sir.
8	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Okay.
9	MR. HORTON: And on Page 8, the number shown for
10	Marianna should stay the same. The number for Fernandina Beach
11	should be .00044.
12	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Very well.
13	MR. HORTON: And I believe that Issue 5 was to be
14	dropped.
15	MS. HOLLEY: That's correct. And this issue will be
16	moved to the proposed stipulation section as well.
17	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Okay. Is that it, Mr. Horton?
18	MR. HORTON: Commissioner, I understand that staff's
19	position on the Fernandina Beach factor also would be .044,
20	which would put us in agreement.
21	MS. HOLLEY: That's correct.
22	MR. HORTON: Okay. Thank you. And that's it.
23	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Thank you. Based on that,
24	Ms. Holley, are there any changes that need to be made?
25	MS. HOLLEY: Only that

1	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Just move Fernandina Beach down
2	to
3	MS. HOLLEY: Right. Well, that issue will be
4	completely moved to the proposed stipulation. So there won't
5	be a separate position for staff and FPUC. It'll just be one
6	stipulated issue.
7	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Very well. Moving on to the
8	exhibit list. Are there any changes?
9	MR. GUYTON: Florida Power & Light has a change. On
10	the exhibit identified for Ken Getchell, we need to remove
11	Appendix A in light of a ruling on confidentiality. That
12	doesn't need to be, become part of the record. And if we could
13	note that for CT-6, that that would be the redacted copy of, of
14	that exhibit.
15	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Okay. Mr. Horton, any changes?
16	No?
17	MR. HORTON: No, sir.
18	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Okay. Mr. Badders.
19	MR. BADDERS: Yes, actually. On Issue Number 2 for
20	Gulf Power where we have a listing of the rate classes, I think
21	you'll find that at Page 11, we list rate class GST. That
22	needs to be struck, and we need to add, on the line with GSD
23	and GSDT
24	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Yes.
25	MR. BADDERS: we need to add GSTOU. It was a

1	typographical error.
2	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: I'm sorry. Can you say that
3	again?
4	MR. BADDERS: Add GSTOU. It's a different it's a
5	new rate class. That would be the only change.
6	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Mr. McGee.
7	MR. McGEE: No changes.
8	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: No changes. Mr. Beasley.
9	MR. BEASLEY: No changes, sir.
10	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Thank you. Ms. Holley, I'm not
11	showing any pending motions.
12	MS. HOLLEY: No, sir.
13	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Okay. And the it seems that
14	the is the confidentiality matter listed here already taken
15	care of?
16	MS. HOLLEY: Yes, sir.
17	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Okay. So we can strike
18	MS. HOLLEY: Strike that.
19	COMMISSIONER BAEZ: Strike that. Any other changes
20	that need to be brought? No? All right. That takes care of
21	the 02.
