The Florida Public Service Commission will consider at its December 2, 2003, Agenda Conference, Docket No. 031000-EI, Application of Florida Power & Light Company for authority to issue and sell securities pursuant to Section 366.04, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 25-8, Florida Administrative Code. The Company seeks PSC approval pursuant to Section 366.04, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 25-8, Florida Administrative Code, to issue and sell, and/or exchange any combination of the long-term debt and equity securities and/or to assume liabilities or obligations as guarantor, endorser, or surety in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$4.5 billion during calendar year 2004. In addition, the Company seeks permission to issue and sell short-term securities during the calendar years 2004 and 2005 in an amount or amounts such that the aggregate principal amount of short-term securities outstanding at the time of any such sale will not exceed 25% of the Company's gross revenues during the preceding twelve months of operation.
