

As I indicated in my previous letter (October 20, 2003) in response to your  
letter to me of October 15, 2003, we do still wish to have the Commission  
hear our complaint about the ERU's we have been charged by K W Resort  
Utility to connect to their collection system.

We have just completed a reroute of our existing water distribution system  
with a single "deduct meter", so that we can correctly pay K W Resort  
Utility for only the water that actually goes to their facility. The Utility is  
being allowed to confirm that our system will correctly produce a fair bill for  
our usage of their plant, and have audited us for compliance.

With this just occurring, we will need a few months to produce  
documentation of our sewer use so that a fair evaluation can be made by the  
PSC of what our ERU's should be. We respectfully ask for an extension of  
the November 3, 2003 deadline, and the December 16, 2003 Commission  
docket so that we can submit accurate information for your consideration.
