If the Commission's Order is not protested, the company's PATS Certificate No. 2358 should be cancelled administratively. If Telaleasing Enterprises, Inc.'s certificate is cancelled in accordance with the Commission's Order from this recommendation, Telaleasing Enterprises, Inc. should be required to immediately cease and desist providing pay telephone service in Florida.
