RE: Docket No. 030340-WU - Application for transfer of facilities of Community Water Co-Op, Inc., an exempt utility in Marion County, to Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc. (holder of Certificate No. 363-W); and for amendment of Certificate No. 363-W to add territory. (Deferred from October 7, 2003 conference; revised recommendation filed.)

ISSUE 1: Should the transfer of water facilities from Community Water Co-op, Inc. to Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc., and amendment of Sunshine's service territory be approved?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The transfer of the Community water facilities to Sunshine is in the public interest and should be approved. The effective date of the transfer should be November 1, 2002. Certificate No. 363-W should be amended to include the territory described in Attachment A of staff's October 22, 2003 memorandum. Also, Sunshine should provide copies of the recorded 99-year lease, the recorded assignment of the 99-year lease, and the recorded warranty deed within 30 days of the Commission's Order approving of the transfer.
