## AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORIZATION

SANLANDO UTILITIES CORPORATION, ("Applicant" or "Sanlando"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, hereby amends Paragraphs 8 and 10 of its Application for Amendment of Certificate Nos. 247-W and 189-S, as follows:

8. The approval of this Application is in the public interest because it will effectuate the settlement of the boundary overlap dispute between Sanlando and Florida Water Services Corporation and will clarify the utility responsible for providing service to the Revised Service Area. Sanlando has been providing water and wastewater service to customers in the Extension Area and will continue to do so without any changes in connections, or interruption or curtailment of service. The Deleted Area is within the Florida Water Services wastewater service area. Although there are currently no active wastewater customers in the Deleted Area, Florida Water Services will be responsible for providing wastewater service to any customers in the Deleted Area who may, in the future, request service.

10. Sanlando currently serves all active water customers within the Extension Area. There are no active wastewater BER-DATE

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customers in the Deleted Area. Florida Water Services will be responsible for serving any wastewater customers in the Deleted Area who may request wastewater service. The amendment of Sanlando's water and wastewater certificates by the addition of the Extension Area to its certificated water services area, and the deletion of the Deleted Area from its certificated wastewater service area, will not interrupt, curtail or otherwise affect the provision of water or wastewater service to existing customers.
