In response to Notice of Service from Rose, Sundstrom & Bentley, LLP request for production of documents and interrogatories, Linda B. Bamfield gives notice as to the following:

1. The relevant questions posed in Island Environmental Utility's First Set of Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents to Linda Bamfield (Nos. 1-64) will be addressed as part of her testimony scheduled to be filed on November 14th, 2003. I see no reason to waste the valuable time of all of the interested parties, and in particular the staff of the Florida Public Service Commission, with reviewing duplicated information that is going to be forthcoming in a matter of days.

2. Beyond the abovementioned questions, I object and refuse to respond to questions that are not relevant to Docket No. 020745-SU.

I am objecting to a proposal to provide wastewater service at my homestead property. The septic system on my property is sufficient to maintain our household and conforms to Charlotte County regulations.

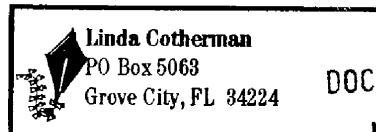
