AT&T MOTION FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), Florida Administrative Code, AT&T Communications of the Southern States, LLC (AT&T) hereby files this Motion for Temporary Protective Order and in support states:

- 1. In conjunction with the instant Motion, AT&T is filing the Direct Testimony of Mr. Richard Guepe. The testimony contains proprietary confidential business information of AT&T.
- 2. The Office of Public Counsel (OPC) is a party in the above reference dockets and has requested that it be provided a copy of the confidential version of AT&T's witness Guepe's testimony.

3. To facilitate the exchange of confidential information with OPC during the pendency of a proceeding, Rule 25-22.006(6)(c) provides that persons agreeing to allow the OPC to inspect or take possession of utility information may request a temporary protective order that exempts the information from disclosure pursuant to Section 119.07(1), Florida Statutes. The filing of a Motion for Temporary Protective Order precludes public disclosure of utility information in the possession of the OPC during the pendency of a proceeding.
