AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF MAJORITY ORGANIZATIONAL CONTROL

Hometown America, L.L.C. ("Hometown") and Chateau Communities, Inc. ("Chateau") (collectively referred to as "Applicants"), by and through their undersigned attorneys, hereby file this Amendment to Application for Transfer of Majority Organizational Control, and state as follows:

- 1. The Joint Application for Approval of the Transfer of Majority Organization Control of Del Tura Phase I, LLC and CWS Communities LP as the Result of the Acquisition by Hometown America, L.L.C. of the Stock of Chateau Communities, Inc. ("Application") was filed in this docket on October 23, 2003.
- 2. Paragraph 12 of the Application states in part: "The books, records, and original source documents of the Utilities shall be maintained in Florida, in compliance with Fla. Admin. Code R. 25-30.115(1), and in accordance with the affidavit attached hereto as Attachment "G."" Since the time of merger, it has been determined that, consistent with Hometown company policy, the better recordkeeping method would be to continue the manner of recordkeeping currently in effect at the three utilities, that is, that copies of utility invoices and records will be maintained at each utility office, and each utility office will have computer access to general ledger and other records, but that the original records will be maintained at Hometown's main headquarters (150 North Wacker Drive, Suite 900, Chicago, IL 60606). This procedure is in

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compliance with the requirements of Fla. Admin. Code Sec. 25-30.110(1)(b), requiring utilities to maintain utility records at the office or offices of the utility within Florida, and to keep those records open for inspection during business hours by Commission staff.

- 3. Prior to merger on October 16, 2003, Chateau utilized this same type of recordkeeping procedure, keeping its original records at its Greenwood Village, Colorado office, but maintaining copies of those invoices on site in Florida as required by rule. Chateau explained this procedure by letters of March 8, 2002 to PSC Staff in response to certain Staff questions in Docket No. 020102-WU, Application for Transfer of Majority Organizational Control of CWS Communities LP, Holder of Certificate No. 518-W in Lake County (Haselton Village), from CWS Communities Trust to Chateau Communities Limited Partnership, and in Docket No. 020122-WS, Request for Approval of Transfer of Majority Organization Control of CWS Communities LP d/b/a Palm Valley, holder of Certificate Nos. 277-W and 223-S in Seminole County, from CWS Communities Trust to Chateau Communities Limited Partnership. This method of recordkeeping was found to be acceptable by Staff.
- 4. Consistent with the determination to continue to utilize the same recordkeeping method as is currently used, the Application Attachment "G" affidavit which predates this determination should be considered withdrawn from this Application.

WHEREFORE, Applicants request that the Application be amended as set forth in this Amendment to Application of Transfer of Majority Organizational Control.
