RE: Docket No.030842-TP - Notice of adoption of existing interconnection, unbundling, collocation, and resale agreement between Sprint-Florida, Incorporated and MCI metro Access Transmission Services LLC, by Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI.

By letter dated August 20, 2003, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated filed a request for approval of adoption of existing interconnection, unbundling, collocation, and resale agreement entered into between Sprint-Florida, Incorporated and MCI metro Access Transmission Services LLC which was deemed approved in Docket No. 020389-TP. Business Telecom, Inc. d/b/a BTI is adopting the interconnection, unbundling, resale, and collocation agreement approved by the Commission in its entirety pursuant to Section 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.

Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(i) requires that a local exchange carrier shall make available any interconnection, service, or network element provided under an agreement approved by the state commission to any other requesting telecommunications carrier upon the same terms and conditions as those provided in the agreement in its entirety.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on October 30, 2003. The filing met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.6.b of the Administrative Procedures Manual in that it complies with Section 252(i) of the Act. Accordingly, with this Memorandum, the docket is hereby closed.
