This letter is in response to Docket No. 030943-TI Order No. PSC-03-1468-PAA-TI, involuntarily revoking the certificate of Telecom New Zealand (TNZ). Staff contends that TNZ never paid the Regulatory Assessment Fee for 2002. On December 8th, TNZ filed the Florida Regulatory Fee report and a check for \$53.00, the amount owed. This letter was accompanied by a letter asking for a voluntary cancellation of the certificate and the tariff. The check, number 3040, cleared the bank on December 16, 2003. A copy of this check can be provide upon request. We understand that this most likely is just an oversight and are requesting that TNZ be removed from this docket involuntarily canceling the tariff. We request that TNZ be allowed to voluntarily withdraw its certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications service as granted in Docket No. 010387-TI, Order No. PSC-01-1557-CO-TI. TNZ has no customers in the state of Florida who would be affected by this action.
