- 1. On December 15, 2003, BellSouth filed its response to AT&T's Seventh Request for Production of Documents (No. 88), dated November 25, 2003. In addition, BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent with respect to its response to AT&T's Seventh Request for Production of Documents, No. 88.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06(3)(a), BellSouth hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the information contained in BellSouth's Response AT&T's Seventh Request for Production, No. 88 includes confidential business information utilized by BellSouth to conduct business.
