REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

1. On January 8, 2004, BellSouth filed the Supplemental Direct Testimony of Shelley W. Padgett with Exhibits SWP-1 through SWP-10. Exhibits SWP-3 and SWP-8 to the Supplemental Direct Testimony of Shelley W. Padgett contain information that is proprietary to BellSouth and that contains customer specific proprietary information.

2. BellSouth hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the information contained in Exhibits SWP-3 and SWP-8 of the Supplemental Direct Testimony of Shelley W. Padgett contain confidential business information and customer specific information that is proprietary to BellSouth. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A. Public disclosure of this information would cause competitive harm to BellSouth and provide competitors with an unfair advantage in future negotiations. The information discussed in Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable and BellSouth strives to keep it secret.
