
Dear Ms. McCoy,



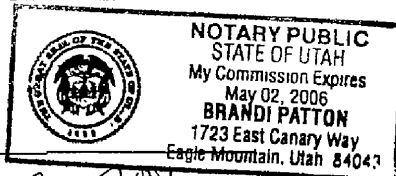

I am the analyst assigned to process the cancellation request. In order to complete the request, the Company needs to pay the 2003 Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) or state in a letter on Company letterhead, with an original signature, their intent to pay those fees on or before January 31, 2004.

I also need a copy of the notice Glyphics mailed to its customers prior to the customer base switch to the new Company.
