BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On December 30, 2003, BellSouth filed its Supplemental Response to AT&T of the Southern States, LLC's ("AT&T") Subpoena Duces Tecum Without Deposition (hereinafter "AT&T's subpoena) and Response to MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC and MCI WorldCom's ("MCI") Subpoena Duces Tecum Without Deposition (hereinafter "MCI's subpoena). In addition, BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent with respect to BellSouth's Supplemental Responses to AT&T's Subpoena and Response to MCI's Subpoena. The BellSouth's Notice of Intent was filed in respect to Subpoena Item Nos. 1 & 2, provided on CD, and Subpoena Item No 3. As clarification, the document produced in response to Item No 3 was also responsive to AT&T's Third Set of Interrogatories, Item No. 125, and was labeled as such.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.06(3)(a), BellSouth hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the information contained in BellSouth's Supplemental Response to AT&T's Subpoena and Response to MCI's Subpoena includes confidential third party information and that is protected by the FCC's Customer Proprietary Network information

rules. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A. Public disclosure of this information would cause competitive harm to the third-party providers. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential, customer proprietary information pursuant to Section 364.24 and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

- 3. Attachment A to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.
- 4. Attachment B to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification is redacted copies of the document containing the confidential information.
- 5. Attachment C to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification is a highlighted copy of the document containing the confidential information.
