to request confidential classification of the responses in the documents labeled Exhibit A and
B. These responses are provided pursuant to a cooperative agreement between Time Warner
and BellSouth.

Time Warner's request for confidential classification is made pursuant to Section
364.183(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code. The
information contained in the documents is considered proprietary confidential business
information, as that term is defined in Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes. As such, this
information is exempt from Section 119.07(1) and Section 24(a), Article I of the State
Constitution. The information is a trade secret and relates to competitive interests, the
disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of Time Warner. Additionally, the
information is intended to be private, and has not been otherwise disclosed by Time Warner.
