**BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S
REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

1. On February 3, 2004, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. filed its Response to Sprint Communications Company Limited Partnership an Sprint-Florida, Inc.'s ("Sprint") First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1-10), and Second Request for Production of Documents (No. 2), dated January 14, 2004. The CD ROM provided in response to Interrogatory No. 1 includes confidential business information as well as customer specific proprietary information.

1. BellSouth hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the information provided on the CD ROM provided in response to Sprint's First Set of Interrogatories, Item No. 1 contains confidential business information and customer specific information that is proprietary to BellSouth. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A. Public disclosure of this information would cause competitive harm to BellSouth and provide competitors with an unfair advantage in future negotiations. The information discussed in Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable and BellSouth strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information should be classified as

confidential business information and customer proprietary information pursuant to Section 364.24 and Section 364.183, *Florida Statutes*. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

2. Attachment A to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.

3. The information discussed in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable, BellSouth treats this information as confidential in all requests, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

4. The original of this Request was filed today with the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and a copy was served on the Parties.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth respectfully requests that, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, the Commission enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.
