No Motion for Rehearing will be entertained by the Court. See Fla. R. App. P. 9.330(d).

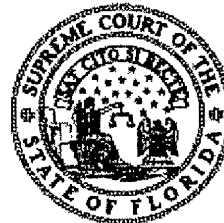
