NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Rule 25-22.080(3), Florida Administrative Code, that the Florida Public Service Commission has received the petition of Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) for determination of need for a proposed electrical power plant in Dade County. The petitioner proposes the construction of a new natural-gas fired, four-on-one combined cycle facility located adjacent to FPL's current Turkey Point complex. Once completed, Turkey Point Unit 5 will have a summer net capacity of approximately 1,144 MW, and an approximate winter rating of 1,181 MW. This matter has been assigned Commission Docket No. 040206-EI.


