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<u>Issue 2</u>: What is the rate base of Virginia City at the time of transfer? <u>Recommendation</u>: The rate base for transfer purposes is \$31,276, as of December 30, 2002.

<u>Issue 3</u>: Should an acquisition adjustment be included in the calculation of rate base? <u>Recommendation</u>: No. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.0371(2), Florida Administrative Code, an acquisition adjustment should not be included in rate base.

<u>Issue 4</u>: Should the rates and charges approved for this utility be continued?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. VCUC should continue charging the rates and charges approved for this utility system until authorized to change by the Commission in a subsequent proceeding. The tariff reflecting the change in ownership should be effective for services provided or connections made on or after the stamped approval date on the tariff sheets.
