**GRANDE COMMUNICATIONS NETWORKS, INC.'S
REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

COMES NOW, Grande Communications Networks, Inc. ("Grande") pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification for its responses to Staff's 2003 TRO Data Request and to discovery from BellSouth.

1. Grande Communications Networks, Inc. was not a party to this proceeding but did provide information to Staff in the nature of a response to a data request and a separate response to a discovery request from BellSouth, both of which became part of the record in this proceeding. The response to BellSouth was provided pursuant to protective agreement and the responses to the Staff Data Request was filed with a claim of confidentiality pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code..

2. With respect to the response to Staff's 2003 TRO Data Request, filed December 9, 2003, the confidential responses are included on page 17 of 26 of the switching data request and pages 1 and 2 of 2 of the loop request.

3. With respect to the response to BellSouth discovery, filed November 24, 2003, the confidential responses are included in Attachment 1 to that discovery response and specifically the responses to Interrogatories 2, 3, and 6b. Information similar to that given to


BellSouth was provided to Staff in Grande's response to the PSC Staff Data Request, specifically on page 17 of 26 of the switching data request and pages 1 and 2 of 2 of the loop request.

4. The information which Grande provided is considered to be and is treated by Grande as confidential and proprietary. Both the interrogatory responses and the data request reveal information as to capacity and capabilities to provide service and specific customer information. This information reveals relative to both current and potential business and can be used by Grande's competitors to the disadvantage of Grande and its customers. Disclosure of this information would impair the competitive business of Grande and section 364.183, Florida Statutes allows for an exemption from public disclosure requirements of section 119.07, Florida Statutes when disclosure would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information. Grande would thus request that the Commission grant the requested confidentiality.

5. Enclosed herein are copies of the public documents with the confidential information redacted and a sealed envelope with the confidential information.

Based on the foregoing, Grande Communications Networks, Inc. requests the Commission to enter an order finding the identified information to be confidential, proprietary business information exempt from public disclosure.

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
