

Dear Mr. Milton:

We have received the financial records you sent on January 31, 2003, and the auditing staff is currently reviewing those records to determine if they are sufficient. On February 4, 2003, I called you regarding your company's response to the Commission's proposed agency action to penalize Florida Commercial PayFon, Inc. \$10,000 for its apparent violation of Rule 25-4.019, Florida Administrative Code, in Order No. PSC-03-0134-PAA-TC, issued on January 27, 2003. As I explained in our phone conversation, the financial records you submitted does not resolve the proposed penalty for the apparent rule violation. Also, based on your comments during our conversation, I am not sure that you understood what the proposed penalty is for. Please understand that the proposed penalty is not an increase in your regulatory assessment fee, it is part of an enforcement proceeding for failing to provide Commission staff with the necessary records in accordance with the rules.

The purpose of my letter is to remind you about the upcoming deadline to respond to the Commission's proposed agency action, including the \$10,000 penalty. Pursuant with our procedures, you may submit a settlement proposal, in writing, whereby you should offer to make a voluntary monetary contribution to the Florida General Revenue Fund in an amount less than the proposed penalty of \$10,000. Another course of action is to protest the Commission's proposed agency action and request a hearing in accordance with Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code. In either case, your company's settlement proposal or protest must be received by the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 17, 2003.



Dear Mr. Milton:

We have received the financial records you sent on January 31, 2003, and the auditing staff is currently reviewing those records to determine if they are sufficient. On February 4, 2003, I called you regarding your company's response to the Commission's proposed agency action to penalize Florida Commercial PayFon, Inc. \$10,000 for its apparent violation of Rule 25-4.019, Florida Administrative Code, in Order No. PSC-03-0134-PAA-TC, issued on January 27, 2003. As I explained in our phone conversation, the financial records you submitted does not resolve the proposed penalty for the apparent rule violation. Also, based on your comments during our conversation, I am not sure that you understood what the proposed penalty is for. Please understand that the proposed penalty is not an increase in your regulatory assessment fee, it is part of an enforcement proceeding for failing to provide Commission staff with the necessary records in accordance with the rules.

The purpose of my letter is to remind you about the upcoming deadline to respond to the Commission's proposed agency action, including the \$10,000 penalty. Pursuant with our procedures, you may submit a settlement proposal, in writing, whereby you should offer to make a voluntary monetary contribution to the Florida General Revenue Fund in an amount less than the proposed penalty of \$10,000. Another course of action is to protest the Commission's proposed agency action and request a hearing in accordance with Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code. In either case, your company's settlement proposal or protest must be received by the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 17, 2003.
