Dear Ms. Daniel:

This letter confirms that HV Utility Systems, L.L.C. has been given until the end of April 2004 in which to respond to your February 20, 2004 informal information request relating to this docket. The reason for this extension is that the Utility is hopeful that current negotiations between the Utility's affiliate, Hacienda Village, and the homeowner's association will result in settlement of a dispute that among other matters relates to the park's collecting certain payments pursuant to the September 11, 2002 letter which you reference in your information request. Resolution of the dispute through settlement would likely address disposition of those payments and answer your question fully.

In response to Christin Romig's inquiry, HV Utility Systems, L.L.C. will be paying or has paid the 2003 regulatory assessment fees and will be responsible for filing or has filed the 2003 annual report, and will be responsible for subsequent years. Additionally, and in partial response to your February 20 information request, the Utility has a copy of the NARUC systems of accounts and is committed to following the Florida Public Service Commission rules and orders related to maintaining its books and records.
