STATUS REPORT

To the Creditors:

You will recall that Utility.com was one of the California energy reseller companies affected by the Fall 2000 energy crisis. The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) subsequently issued administrative orders to recalculate energy costs and provide refunds to energy resellers, including Utility.com, for energy purchased between October 2, 2000 and June 20, 2001.

Ben Reyes, Esq., special counsel to the Assignee (CMA), has reported that the California Independent System Operator (Cal ISO), which schedules the power load on the California grid, and the Automated Power Exchange (APX), the clearinghouse for energy transactions, have begun to resettle Utility.com's accounts. However, he anticipates only **modest refunds to the estate**, because Utility.com was a small reseller with less than 5,000 customers.

Mr. Reyes reported the resettlement efforts have been hampered by a variety of technical issues and complicated by several levels of review by state and federal agencies. He expects the final APX and ISO recalculations should be completed by June 2004.

Creditors are requested to advance their files to the end of July 2004 for an update. You will be advised if any significant developments occur in the interim.
