Dear Mr. Bircher::

We have determined eligibility for staff assistance filed by Ranch Mobile WWTP, Inc., (Ranch Mobile or utility). We find that pursuant to Section 367.0814(1), Florida Statutes, the utility is not eligible for the staff assisted rate case (SARC) filing. Although Ranch Mobile is considered a Class C utility by National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners (NARUC) (annual revenues of less than \$200,000), it is not eligible for a SARC because the utility's gross revenues are above \$150,000.

In order to obtain rate relief, Ranch Mobile may initiate a file and suspend rate case, pursuant

to 367.081, Florida Statutes. I am enclosing a copy of the Class C minimum filing requirements (MFRs) along with a copy of Rules 25-30.433 and 25-30.443, Florida Administrative Code, (F.A.C.), which explains the requirements of a file and suspend rate case and the MFRs. Also enclosed is a copy of Rule 25-30.020, F.A.C., which shows the filing fees for a file and suspend rate case. In addition, I am enclosing a copy of the current leverage formula adopted by Commission Order No. CMP -PSC-03-0707-PAA-WS, and an example of a test year approval request. You may fill out the attached MFRs or, if you prefer, I can send you a disc containing a Lotus file that can be used to COM generate the MFRs.

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The first step in initiating a file and suspend rate case is to mail your test year approval request to Chairman Braulio L. Baez.
