In March of 2004, the Commission voted to implement an electronic telephone filing pilot program during an Internal Affairs conference. On May 19, 2004, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) filed a petition for a temporary waiver of Rules 25-9.004 and 25-9.006, Florida Administrative Code, to participate in the pilot program. Upon receipt of BellSouth's petition, staff contacted the company and informed BellSouth that the pilot program was not subject to Rules 25-9.004 and 25-9.006, Florida Administrative Code. Therefore, on May 21, 2004, BellSouth withdrew its petition for waiver of Rules 25-9.004 and 25-9.006, Florida Administrative Code. No further action is required; therefore this docket may be administratively closed in accordance with Section 2.07 of the Aministrative Procedures Manual.
