Applicant, Oak Springs, LLC (hereinafter "the Utility", "the Applicant" or "Oak Springs"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to Sections 367.031 and 367.045, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.033, Florida Administrative Code, files this Application for a certificate to operate a water utility in Orange and Lake Counties and in support thereof states:

Oak Springs, LLC is a Limited Liability Corporation incorporated in Florida on December 9, 2002.

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### IV.

Because the Applicant is a Limited Liability Corporation, it has no corporate officers and directors. However, the name and address of the Managing Member is:

The Utility will be operated as a part of the overall company which owns and operates a mobile home rental community, rather than as a separate entity. The names of the persons or entities owning an interest in the Applicant are as follows:

The Applicant has not made an election under Internal Revenue Code Section 1362 to be an S Corporation.

### VI.

The Applicant has the financial and technical ability to provide water service to the area applied for herein. Prior to the certification of the Utility, the water system and all of the existing related facilities which will now be utilized by the Utility in providing service to the territory applied for herein, have been operated for many years by Oak Springs, LLC and its predecessors as an exempt system. The system was operated as part of a mobile home rental community with no separate charge for water service. The Utility will continue to employ operations, maintenance, management, and technical advisor personnel necessary to ensure continued efficient provision of high quality water service to the various customers of the Utility and to meet the future and expanding needs anticipated for water services within the proposed territory.

### VII.

The Applicant has the technical ability to provide the water service to the proposed territory as applied for herein, and has provided such service on a continuous basis for many years. The Applicant can provide water service as applied for herein and the expansion of that service as and when needed. All of the water facilities currently utilized in providing service to the territory have been operated by the Applicant as an exempt system for several

years. Because of the concern with, and subsequent requirement by the Water Management District with water service provided without separate charge, the Utility has decided to become a regulated entity and to begin charging for such service. The Utility has employed and will continue to employ appropriate management, maintenance and operation personnel to ensure that the system is maintained in accordance with all regulatory requirements and to enlist the services of persons familiar with PSC regulation to assist in ensuring proper reporting and compliance with all applicable Public Service Commission Rules and Regulations.

The Applicant currently operates all existing Utility facilities in question and has the appropriate certificates and licenses to operate those existing supplied facilities. The Utility will continue to employ either through direct employment or through contractual arrangements, the same personnel and hire additional qualified persons as needed in order to continue to provide the same high quality of service as it has provided in the past as an exempt entity.

### VIII.

The Applicant has fee simple ownership in the land on facilities utilized for Utility purposes are located. The attached Deed recognizes that right for long term continuous use of that property. This is attached as **Exhibit "A"**.

### IX.

There is currently a need for potable water service within the proposed service territory applied for herein. That service

consists of existing residential service. The needs for these various services are throughout the service territory as depicted in the maps included as **Exhibit "B"**.

The Utility has not made inquiries from other Utilities within the area who might be able to provide service to this territory. Because the existing facilities are already in place and providing this service, the only entity that can reasonably provide such service is the owner of those facilities, which is the Applicant herein. Any attempts to obtain service from an outside entity would dramatically increase the cost of such service and quite possibly result in a decrease in the quality of service provided.

In addition the need for continuous service to those already being provided service at no cost, makes such an alternative impractical.

х.

Through funding and the financial support of its mobile home park operators, the Utility will have ample financial backing to ensure the safe, efficient and sufficient provision of potable water service to the territory applied for herein and the expansion as needed of the water treatment and distribution facilities and the proposed service territory to meet all future needs therein. The Utility has not yet begun collecting for service and as such has no revenue. Therefore, attached hereto as **Exhibit "C"**, is a recent balance sheet for the Applicant, Oak Springs, LLC, the mobile home property owner. This demonstrates that the Applicant has ample capital resources to support the initial funding of any

financial needs of the Utility and all future needs as they become apparent. In addition there are no substantial additions necessary to the system in order for it to continue to provide good quality water service in conformance with all applicable standards for the foreseeable future. Also attached as part of **Exhibit "C"** is an affidavit from the Managing Member of Oak Springs, LLC ensuring its financial commitment to the Utility company for all future capital requirements.

### XI.

The provision of water service in the proposed service territory, including use of existing facilities as outlined in this Application, will be consistent with the water sections of the local Comprehensive Plans for both Orange and Lake Counties as approved by the Department of Community Affairs.

### XII.

The Applicant is and has been providing water services to these properties at no cost. The Applicant plans to begin providing service to all customers within its service territory for compensation immediately upon approval of the rates and charges as outlined herein and certification by the Commission.

### XIII.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit "D"** is a statement and table concerning the number of equivalent residential connections proposed to be served by the Applicant by meter size and customer class.

### XIV.

Also included in **Exhibit "D"** is a description of the type of customers that Oak Springs, LLC anticipates providing service to.

### XV.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit "E"** are the original and two copies of the sample tariff containing all rates, classifications, charges, rules and regulations consistent with Rule 25-9, Florida Administrative Code, which the Applicant herein intends to utilize in providing water service.

### XVI.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit "F"** is a description of the territory proposed for inclusion in the Utility's certificated service area using township range and section references. This description is in compliance with Rule 25-30.033(1) and 25-30.030(2), F.A.C.

### XVII.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit "G"** are five copies of a map showing the township range and section references with the proposed service territory plotted thereon. The Applicant believes that Exhibit "G" complies with the provisions and intent of Rule 25-30.033(n), F.A.C.

### XVIII.

The Utility currently serves 314 Equivalent Residential Connections. Build out of the development comprises 438 lots and source of supply, pumping, treatment and distribution facilities are in place to serve the entire development at build out. Build out of the development is 438 lots, each of which comprises an ERC.

Under the Utility's existing Consumptive Use Permit No. 2416, the Utility is authorized to pump 57.7 million gallons per year, or 158,082 gallons per day, based upon 350 gallons per day per ERC. This is sufficient capacity to provide for 452 ERCs. Therefore, the Utility has in place the existing capacities and permits to provide service to the entire area at build out.

### XIX.

The Utility currently utilizes aeration and chlorination with storage as its method of water treatment.

### XX.

The Utility is just beginning operation and has not yet received its first dollar of revenue as a regulated utility charging for service and will not receive such revenue until such time as the Florida Public Service Commission approves the appropriate rates and charges for the Utility. However, attached hereto as part of Exhibit "H" is an original cost study and other schedules concerning all of the assets of the Utility to be utilized in the provision of the water services. Also included in this Exhibit are schedules of operation and maintenance expenses anticipated to be incurred in such operation. Those lists of assets and 0 & M expenses are prepared in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-30.115, Florida Administrative Code. As such, Applicant believes that these exhibits comply with the requirements of Rule 25-30.032(1)(r) and (t).

### XXII.

Attached hereto as part of **Exhibit "H"** is a cost study including customer projections supporting the proposed rates and charges and service availability charges as outlined herein.

#### XXIII.

Attached hereto as part of **Exhibit "H"** are the projected costs of the proposed systems by NARUC account number. The related capacity of each system and ERCs in gallons per day.

### XXIV.

Attached hereto as part of **Exhibit "H"** are the projected operating expenses of the proposed systems by NARUC account numbers as currently incurred. Because the Utility is already operated at over 80% of design capacity, the actual costs have been utilized. Also included therein is a schedule showing the Utility capital structure.

### XXV.

Attached hereto as **Exhibit** "I" is an affidavit showing that the Utility has provided notice in accordance with the requirements of Rule 25-30.030, F.A.C. to all those entitled to such notice. The publication notice in compliance with Rule 25-30.030(7), F.A.C. is due to be published on May 29, 2004. Proof of publication will be provided to the Commission as Late-Filed **Exhibit** "J" immediately after it is received from the newspaper utilized for this purpose. A copy of the appropriate notice has also been provided by regular mail or personal service to each of the customers of the system to

be certified. An affidavit of such compliance will be Late-Filed **Exhibit "K"**.

### XXVI.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 367.045(1)(d), Florida Statutes and Rule 25-30.033 and 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code, enclosed is a check for the filing fee in the amount of \$750, which is intended to satisfy the requirements of those rules and statutory sections for a system intended to serve up to 500 ERCs.

### XXVII.

The Applicant herein requests that the Florida Public Service Commission grant this Application and issue a certificate to Oak Springs, LLC to provide water service to the territory requested in Orange and Lake Counties. In addition, the Applicant requests that the Commission in its order granting such a certificate, authorize a collection of the rates proposed herein and implementation of the tariffs as included herein.




Map

- 8.0 "MAIN" A pipe, conduit, or other facility used to convey water service to individual service lines or through other mains.
- 9.0 "RATE" Amount which the Company may charge for water service which is applied to the Customer's actual consumption.
- 10.0 "RATE SCHEDULE" The rate(s) or charge(s) for a particular classification of service plus the several provisions necessary for billing, including all special terms and conditions under which service shall be furnished at such rate or charge.
- 11.0 "SERVICE" As mentioned in this tariff and in agreement with Customers, "Service" shall be construed to include, in addition to all water service required by the Customer, the readiness and ability on the part of the Company to furnish water service to the Customer. Service shall conform to the standards set forth in Section 367.111 of the Florida Statutes.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1.0 <u>GENERAL INFORMATION</u> - These Rules and Regulations are a part of the rate schedules and applications and contracts of the Company and, in the absence of specific written agreement to the contrary, apply without modifications or change to each and every Customer to whom the Company renders water service.

The Company shall provide water service to all Customers requiring such service within its Certificated territory pursuant to Chapter 25-30, Florida Administrative Code and Chapter 367, Florida Statutes.

- 2.0 <u>POLICY DISPUTE</u> Any dispute between the Company and the Customer or prospective Customer regarding the meaning or application of any provision of this tariff shall upon written request by either party be resolved by the Florida Public Service Commission.
- 3.0 <u>APPLICATION</u> In accordance with Rule 25-30.310, Florida Administrative Code, a signed application is required prior to the initiation of service. The Company shall provide each Applicant with a copy of the brochure entitled "Your Water and Wastewater Service," prepared by the Florida Public Service Commission.
- 4.0 <u>APPLICATIONS BY AGENTS</u> Applications for water service requested by firms, partnerships, associations, corporations, and others shall be rendered only by duly authorized parties or agents.
- 5.0 <u>REFUSAL OR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE</u> The Company may refuse or discontinue water service rendered under application made by any member or agent of a household, organization, or business in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.
- 6.0 <u>EXTENSIONS</u> Extensions will be made to the Company's facilities in compliance with Commission Rules and Orders and the Company's tariff.
- 7.0 TYPE AND MAINTENANCE In accordance with Rule 25-30.545, Florida Administrative Code, the Customer's pipes, apparatus and equipment shall be selected, installed, used and maintained in accordance with standard practice and shall conform with the Rules and Regulations of the Company and shall comply with all laws and governmental regulations applicable to same. The Company shall not be responsible for the maintenance and operation of the Customer's pipes and facilities. The Customer expressly agrees not to utilize any appliance or device which is not properly constructed, controlled and protected or which may adversely affect the water service. The Company reserves the right to discontinue or withhold water service to such apparatus or device.
- 8.0 <u>DELINQUENT BILLS</u> When it has been determined that a Customer is delinquent in paying any bill, water service may be discontinued after the Company has mailed or presented a written notice to the Customer in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.

9.0 CONTINUITY OF SERVICE - In accordance with Rule 25-30.250, Florida Administrative Code, the Company will at all times use reasonable diligence to provide continuous water service and, having used reasonable diligence, shall not be liable to the Customer for failure or interruption of continuous water service.

If at any time the Company shall interrupt or discontinue its service, all Customers affected by said interruption or discontinuance shall be given not less than 24 hours written notice.

10.0 <u>LIMITATION OF USE</u> - Water service purchased from the Company shall be used by the Customer only for the purposes specified in the application for water service. Water service shall be rendered to the Customer for the Customer's own use and shall not sell or otherwise dispose of such water service supplied by the Company.

In no case shall a Customer, except with the written consent of the Company, extend his lines across a street, alley, lane, court, property line, avenue, or other way in order to furnish water service to the adjacent property through one meter even though such adjacent property may be owned by him. In case of such unauthorized extension, sale, or disposition of service, the Customer's water service will be subject to discontinuance until such unauthorized extension, remetering, sale or disposition of service is discontinued and full payment is made to the Company for water service rendered by the Company (calculated on proper classification and rate schedules) and until reimbursement is made in full to the Company for all extra expenses incurred for clerical work, testing, and inspections. (This shall not be construed as prohibiting a Customer from remetering.)

- 11.0 CHANGE OF CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION No changes or increases in the Customer's installation, which will materially affect the proper operation of the pipes, mains, or stations of the Company, shall be made without written consent of the Company. The Customer shall be liable for any charge resulting from a violation of this Rule.
- 12.0 PROTECTION OF COMPANY'S PROPERTY The Customer shall exercise reasonable diligence to protect the Company's property. If the Customer is found to have tampered with any Company property or refuses to correct any problems reported by the Company, service may be discontinued in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code. In the event of any loss or damage to property of the Company caused by or arising out of carelessness, neglect, or misuse by the Customer, the cost of making good such loss or repairing such damage shall be paid by the Customer.

13.0 <u>INSPECTION OF CUSTOMER'S INSTALLATION</u> - All Customer's water service installations or changes shall be inspected upon completion by a competent authority to ensure that the Customer's piping, equipment, and devices have been installed in accordance with accepted standard practice and local laws and governmental regulations. Where municipal or other governmental inspection is required by local rules and ordinances, the Company cannot render water service until such inspection has been made and a formal notice of approval from the inspecting authority has been received by the Company.

Not withstanding the above, the Company reserves the right to inspect the Customer's installation prior to rendering water service, and from time to time thereafter, but assumes no responsibility whatsoever for any portion thereof.

- 14.0 <u>ACCESS TO PREMISES</u> In accordance with Rule 25-30.320(2)(f), Florida Administrative Code, the Customer shall provide the duly authorized agents of the Company access at all reasonable hours to its property. If reasonable access is not provided, service may be discontinued pursuant to the above rule.
- 15.0 <u>RIGHT-OF-WAY OR EASEMENTS</u> The Customer shall grant or cause to be granted to the Company, and without cost to the Company, all rights, easements, permits, and privileges which are necessary for the rendering of water service.
- 16.0 <u>CUSTOMER BILLING</u> Bills for water service will be rendered Monthly, Bimonthly, or Quarterly as stated in the rate schedule.

In accordance with Rule 25-30.335, Florida Administrative Code, the Company may not consider a Customer delinquent in paying his or her bill until the twenty-first day after the Company has mailed or presented the bill for payment.

A municipal or county franchise tax levied upon a water or wastewater public Company shall not be incorporated into the rate for water or wastewater service but shall be shown as a separate item on the Company's bills to its Customers in such municipality or county.

If a Company utilizes the base facility and usage charge rate structure and does not have a Commission authorized vacation rate, the Company shall bill the Customer the base facility charge regardless of whether there is any usage.

17.0 <u>TERMINATION OF SERVICE</u> - When a Customer wishes to terminate service on any premises where water service is supplied by the Company, the Company may require reasonable notice in accordance with Rule 25-30.325, Florida Administrative Code.

- 18.0 PAYMENT OF WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICE BILLS CONCURRENTLY In accordance with Rule 25-30.320(2)(g), Florida Administrative Code, when both water and wastewater service are provided by the Company, payment of any water service bill rendered by the Company to a Customer shall not be accepted by the Company without the simultaneous or concurrent payment of any wastewater service bill rendered by the Company.
- 19.0 <u>UNAUTHORIZED CONNECTIONS</u> <u>WATER</u> Any unauthorized connections to the Customer's water service shall be subject to immediate discontinuance without notice, in accordance with Rule 25-30.320, Florida Administrative Code.
- 20.0 <u>METERS</u> All water meters shall be furnished by and remain the property of the Company and shall be accessible and subject to its control, in accordance with Rule 25-30.230, Florida Administrative Code.
- 21.0 <u>ALL WATER THROUGH METER</u> That portion of the Customer's installation for water service shall be so arranged to ensure that all water service shall pass through the meter. No temporary pipes, nipples or spaces are permitted and under no circumstances are connections allowed which may permit water to by-pass the meter or metering equipment.
- 22.0 <u>ADJUSTMENT OF BILLS</u> When a Customer has been undercharged as a result of incorrect application of the rate schedule, incorrect reading of the meter, incorrect connection of the meter, or other similar reasons, the amount may be billed to the Customer as the case may be pursuant to Rule 25-30.350, Florida Administrative Code.
- 23.0 <u>ADJUSTMENT OF BILLS FOR METER ERROR</u> When meter tests are made by the Commission or by the Company, the accuracy of registration of the meter and its performance shall conform with Rule 25-30.262, Florida Administrative Code and any adjustment of a bill due to a meter found to be in error as a result of any meter test performed whether for unauthorized use or for a meter found to be fast, slow, non-registering, or partially registering, shall conform with Rule 25-30.340, Florida Administrative Code.
- 24.0 <u>METER ACCURACY REQUIREMENTS</u> All meters used by the Company should conform to the provisions of Rule 25-30.262, Florida Administrative Code.
- 25.0 FILING OF CONTRACTS Whenever a Developer Agreement or Contract, Guaranteed Revenue Contract, or Special Contract or Agreement is entered into by the Company for the sale of its product or services in a manner not specifically covered by its Rules and Regulations or approved Rate Schedules, a copy of such contracts or agreements shall be filed with the Commission prior to its execution in accordance with Rule 25-9.034 and Rule 25-30.550, Florida Administrative Code. If such contracts or agreements are approved by the Commission, a conformed copy shall be placed on file with the Commission within 30 days of execution.
