Ms. Isler:

I am the Trustee for the estate of Delta Phones, Inc. (the "Debtor") in the above-referenced case. I am in receipt of your letter dated March 24, 2004. In your letter, you requested that I cancel the Debtor's competitive local exchange company certificate in Florida (the "Certificate") and request that the Public Service Commission write off any unpaid Regulatory Assessment Fees. Because the Certificate may be property of the Debtor's estate, I must first obtain the Bankruptcy Court's approval to abandon the property before I can request that that Public Service Commission cancel the Certificate. I am filing a motion to abandon the Certificate with the Bankruptcy Court, returnable on May 27, 2004. As soon as the Court enters an order allowing me to abandon the property, I will send you a letter requesting that you cancel the Certificate and write of any unpaid Regulatory Assessment Fees.
