NOTICE OF ESTABLISHMENT OF DEADLINE TO FILE REQUESTS FOR THE ALLOWANCE OF ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE CLAIMS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on May 28, 2002 (the "Petition Date"), the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "Debtors") each filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Court") voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101-1330 (the "Bankruptcy Code").

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Court has entered an Order (the "Administrative Claims Bar Date Order") establishing **August 3, 2004 at 5:00 p.m.** (Eastern Time) (the "Administrative Claims Bar Date") as the last date and time for the filing of requests for the allowance of administrative expense claims against the Debtors, other than those listed below.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that pursuant to the terms of the Administrative Claims Bar Date Order, other than the parties listed in the "Exceptions" paragraph below, each person or entity, including, without limitation, individuals, partnerships, joint ventures, corporations, estates, trusts and governmental units, which holds or asserts an administrative expense claim against or relating to the Debtors under sections 365, 503(b), 507(a)(1) or any other section of the Bankruptcy Code, for any alleged obligation or liability of the Debtors whatsoever, which arose after the Petition Date but through and including May 27, 2004 (an "Administrative Expense Claim") must file a request for the allowance of such Administrative Expense Claim on or before August 3, 2004 at 5:00 p.m. (Eastern Time).

Exceptions: The Administrative Claims Bar Date applies to all Administrative Expense Claims arising under sections 365, 503(b), 507(a)(1) or any other section of the Bankruptcy Code, **EXCEPT** for the following:

Therefore, the date of a postmark by the U.S. Postal Service or the date of delivery by any other delivery service shall not constitute a date upon which a request for Administrative Expense Claim may be deemed filed. Further, facsimile or e-mail requests are **NOT** acceptable, and will not be valid for any purpose.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that for purposes of the Administrative Claims Bar Date Order and this Notice, the term "claim" means (i) any right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, liquidated, unliquidated, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, legal, equitable, secured or unsecured; or (ii) any right to an equitable remedy for breach of performance if such breach gives rise to a right to payment, whether or not such right to an equitable remedy is reduced to judgment, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, secured or unsecured, arising from May 28, 2002 through May 27, 2004.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the fact that you have received this Notice does not necessarily mean that you have an Administrative Expense Claim against the Debtors. You should not file a request for the allowance of an Administrative Expense Claim if you do not actually hold such a claim against the Debtors.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that copies of the Motion and the Order establishing the Administrative Claims Bar Date are available for inspection during regular business hours at the Offices of the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, 824 North Market Street, 3rd Floor, Wilmington, Delaware 19801.
