

Ms. Isler:

I am the attorney for Ronald R. Peterson, the chapter 7 trustee in the above-referenced case. Pursuant to our previous conversations and as a follow up to Ronald R. Peterson's letter of May 18, 2004, I am writing to inform you that the Trustee filed a motion to abandon property of the estate on May 28, 2004 (the "Motion"), returnable on June 14, 2004. By the Motion, the Trustee is seeking the Bankruptcy Court's approval to abandon the Debtor's competitive local exchange company certificate in Florida (the "Certificate"). As soon as the Bankruptcy Court enters an order allowing the Trustee to abandon the property, the Trustee will send you a letter requesting that you cancel the Certificate and write of any unpaid Regulatory Assessment Fees.
