

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

1. On June 1, 2004, BellSouth filed its Response to the Florida Public Service Commission Staff, hereinafter ("Staff")'s First Set of Interrogatories (Nos. 1-16), First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-6) and First Request for Admissions (Nos. 1-9), portions of which contain confidential business information.

2. Because BellSouth's Response to the Staff's First Set of Interrogatories, Nos. 1, 2 and 10, First Request for Production of Documents No. 2 and First Request for Admissions No. 2 contains confidential business, proprietary information, BellSouth also filed a Notice of Intent. A more specific description of this information is provided in Attachment A. These documents should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183(3)(e), Florida Statutes and is exempt from the Open Records Act.

3. Attachment B to BellSouth's Request for Confidential Classification is redacted copies of the documents containing the confidential information.

5. The information discussed in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable, BellSouth treats this private financial information as confidential in all requests, and this information has not been generally disclosed.


6. The original of this Request was filed today with the Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services and a copy was served on the Parties.
