CPV Gulfcoast, Ltd. appeals an order of the Florida Public Service Commission granting Florida Power & Light Company's two petitions to determine the need for new power generating units at its plants in Martin County and Manatee County, Florida. The Commission's determination of need was made pursuant to section 403.519, Florida Statutes (2001). We have jurisdiction pursuant to article V, section 3(b)(2) of the Florida Constitution.

Having considered the arguments of the parties, we hereby affirm the December 10, 2002, Order of the Public Service Commission Granting Determination of Need.

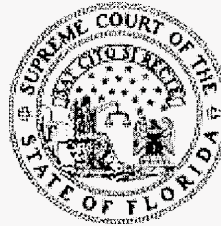
