In accordance with the expedited process established in order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL (Docket No. 010782-TL), Verizon Florida Inc. (Verizon) requests the Florida Public Service Commission to direct the Pooling Administrator (PA) to provide Verizon with two uncontaminated 1,000 number blocks for in Tampa, Florida.

Verizon considers the highlighted information in this letter to be confidential because it contains the customer's name and the customer's planned use of the requested numbers. Verizon is obligated to protect the identity of the customer and competitors could use this information to gain an unfair competitive advantage. Therefore, this filing is made under a Claim of Confidentiality pursuant to F.S. 364.183(1) and Rule 25-22.006(5). Verizon understands the highlighted information must be kept confidential until returned to Verizon. To assist the Commission in processing this request, the name of the customer who initiated the request is Mr.

Mr.

, a Verizon customer, has requested a 1,000 blocks of telephone numbers to meet its dialing plan requirements. This request is necessary since the numbers originally assigned to DTCC were not compatible with the customer's PABX numbering plan. The customer requires a range of DID numbers beginning with the digits 1, 2, 4, 5 or 8 in order to be compatible with their existing dialing plan.

On August 16, 2004 Verizon submitted a Code Request Application Form Part 1A to the PA for the assignment of 1,000 blocks of numbers necessary to meet the request. Verizon completed the application in accordance with the Thousands - Block Number (NXX-X) Pooling Administration Guidelines and completed the necessary Months to Exhaust Certification. A copy of this application is included as Attachment A. DOCUMENT NUMBER - DATE

Verizon submitted the request because Verizon does not have sequential numbers available within the Tampa Central central office to meet the needs.

On August 18, 2004, the PA, via the Pooling Administration System (PAS), denied Verizon's request. This decision, provided by the PAS system, is included as Attachment B.

Under earlier months-to-exhaust procedures, waivers or exceptions were granted where customer hardships were demonstrated or where the service provider's inventory did not have a block of numbers large enough to meet a customer's specific request. Under existing procedures, the PA looks at the number of months to exhaust for the entire rate center without any exceptions. However, paragraph 64 of the FCC's Third Report and Order in the Numbering Resource Optimization docket states that a carrier "... should be able to get additional numbering resources when there is a verifiable need due to the carrier's inability to satisfy a specific customer request." Also, paragraph 64 indicates that "States may not accommodate requests for specific numbers (i.e. vanity numbers), but may grant requests for customers seeking contiguous blocks of numbers." The Florida Commission thus has the authority to review the PA's decisions and reverse them when appropriate.

Verizon seeks the Commission's review of the PA's decision to withhold numbering resources. The PA's decision violates the intent and requirements of the FCC in allowing carriers access to numbering resources to meet specific customer demands upon a sufficient showing of need, and the PA's denial of numbering resources interferes with Verizon's ability to serve this customer.

Verizon requests that the Commission instruct the PA to release the numbering resources necessary to meet the needs of the


