MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc., MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC, Intermedia Communications Inc, MCI WorldCom Network Services, Inc., and Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc., pursuant to Section 364.183(1), Florida Statutes, hereby claims that certain information provided in MCI's Supplemental Response to the 2004 Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) Data Request, Revised Table 1 on a CD-ROM contains confidential and proprietary business information that should be held exempt from public disclosure. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, in the attached envelope is a copy of MCI's Response, Revised Table 1 on a CD-ROM.

In connection with the information on this CD-ROM, please note the following: MCI's internal systems are not set up in a manner that supports the creation of data and calculation of end user demand in the format requested by the Florida PSC. The attached file represents MCI's best estimate at this time of the switched access lines it currently provides via all methods (e.g. self provisioned, special access and Unbundled Loops) to end user customers in Florida by NPA/NXX, as those terms have been defined by the Florida PSC's data request and redefined by Commission staff via email on August 30, 2004. MCI's is currently unable to determine specific customer premise equipment by circuit provisioned. As such, the "type of service" (i.e. analog or digital) provided to end users for self provisioned and special access lines is not currently known, as that terminology is defined by the Table 1 instructions.


