A waiver of all regulated charges associated with MemoryCall Service and BellSouth Voice Mail Service including, but not limited to the Secondary Service Order Charge and the first month's charge for Message Waiting Indication for orders placed through September 24, 2004.

A waiver of termination charges associated with term elections agreements in situations where a business is no longer operational because of the damage from the hurricane, and the business does not reopen or relocate.
