The purpose of this letter is to request that the Commission discontinue the certificate of public convenience and necessity of ACC National Long Distance Corp. (ACC) (Certificate No. 4007). ACC is an indirect subsidiary of TCG South Florida (TCG). ACC presently is certificated to resell interexchange services in State of Florida. ACC currently has no customers or active tariffs in Florida and has ceased providing telecommunications services.

It is important to note that TCG's request to discontinue ACC's certificate will have no impact on any Florida consumers. All services formerly provided by ACC are now being offered by other TCG entities.

Accordingly, by this letter TCG and ACC respectfully request that ACC's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be discontinued.
