**ISSUE 3:** What should be the effective date of the cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

POSITION: The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2005, through December 2005. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2005, and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2005, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective.
