RE:	Docket No. 041203-TP, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BellSouth) Petition for Expedited Review of a Growth Code Denial by the North American Numbering Plan Administration (NANPA) for the Gainesville Exchange (Northwest)

On September 28, 2004, BellSouth submitted a code request application to NANPA for a 10,000 number block to meet a customer request for 500 consecutive numbers. On September 29, 2004, NANPA denied BellSouth application because it did not meet the utilization criteria required for an new block of numbers.

On October 12, 2004, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NANPA's decision to deny a growth code in the Gainesville (Northwest) (GSVLFLNW33E) switch located in the Gainesville rate center. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL (Docket No. 010782-TL) which approved an expedited process for NANPA code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that is it unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NANPA's denial of the numbering resources; and

customer's needs in the Gainesville (Northwest) Switch (GSVLFLNW33E), specifically, an NXX of ten thousand numbers, since this is not a pooling area.
