ALLIED UNIVERSAL CORPORATION AND CHEMICAL FORMULATORS, INC.'S RESPONSE TO TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS AND ODYSSEY MANUFACTURING COMPANY'S RENEWED REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIALITY

Allied Universal Corporation and Chemical Formulators, Inc. ("Allied/CFI"), by and through its undersigned counsel, hereby files the following Response to Tampa Electric Company's ("TECO") Request for Extension of Confidential Classification of Documents and Odyssey Manufacturing Company's ("Odyssey") Renewed Request for Confidentiality, and states as follows:

1. TECO has requested that all documents listed in Attachment B to Order No. PSC-03-0532-CFO-EI ("Order No. 03-0532") be treated as confidential for an additional eighteen (18) months. The documents listed in Attachment B to Order No. 03-0532 were granted confidential classification for a period of eighteen (18) months after April 22, 2003, the date of issuance of Order No. 03-0532, with the confidential status expiring unless a renewed request for confidentiality was filed. TECO has filed such a request as has Odyssey.

- 2. To the extent that the documents listed in Attachment B contain specific proprietary confidential business information listed in Section 366.093(3)(a) and (e), Florida Statutes, such as trade secrets or information relating to competitive interests, Allied/CFI agrees with TECO and Odyssey that such documents should continue to be classified as confidential by the Commission.
- 3. Allied/CFI objects however, to continued confidential classification of the specific following documents included in Attachment B to Order Number 03-0532:
 - A. Document number 07053-01- Rebuttal testimony of Robert N. Namoff and Exhibits RMN-15 through RMN-19. Specifically, Allied/CFI objects to the continued classification of Exhibit RMN-16 to Robert N. Namoff's testimony which includes a copy of the Contract Service Agreement ("CSA") between Tampa Electric and Odyssey; and
 - B. Document number 03681-01 - Original version of CSA between TECO and Allied
 Universal Corp. with Exhibit B.
- 3. Allied/CFI also objects to the continued classification of any and all documents included in Attachment B to Order 03-0532 that contain specific information related to and arising from negotiations between TECO, Odyssey and Allied/CFI culminating in CSAs pursuant to TECO's Commission approved Commercial Industrial Service Rider Tariff ("CISR Tariff").
- 4. Order No. 03-0532 requires that a party seeking continued confidential classification for eighteen (18) months demonstrate "good cause why the period should be extended." The requests of TECO and Odyssey fail to meet that burden and should be denied with respect to the CSAs and the documents as outlined above.
- 4. In support of its request, TECO states only that "while Tampa Electric no longer has a CSIR (sic) tariff in place, its commitments to Allied, CFI and Odyssey continue unabated."

Allied/CFI is not aware of what commitments TECO is referring to and no explanation is provided

in TECO's Request for Extension. With respect to the Allied/CFI and TECO CSA, the Commission

is well aware of Allied/CFI's position that TECO did not keep its commitments to Allied/CFI

resulting in a unilateral termination of that CSA by TECO to the injury and detriment of Allied/CFI

and consumers of liquid chlorine bleach in general.

5. In any case, TECO's authority to offer a CISR rate has expired. As TECO concedes,

its CISR tariff is no longer in place. The need to maintain confidential protection of CISR rate

contracts (the CSAs) and CISR negotiation information to avoid the availability and use of such

contracts by other potential CISR customers in negotiations with TECO no longer exists. There is

no longer a legitimate public policy reason or any type of statutory or Commission order authority

for maintaining the confidentiality of the CSAs entered into between TECO and Odyssey and

between TECO and Allied/CFI or for maintaining the confidentiality of documents that contain

specific information related to and arising from negotiations between TECO, Odyssey and

Allied/CFI culminating in the CSAs. Accordingly, the Commission should deny TECO and

Odysseys's requests for an additional eighteen (18) months of confidential protection for these two

CSAs, and for the documents that contain information related to and arising from negotiations

between the parties that culminated in the CSAs.
