As you know, this law firm represents Environmental Protection Systems of Pine Island, Inc. ("EPS"). It is my understanding that Kevin Cherry and the Staff have discussed the timing of EPS's interconnection with Lee County and the revenue implications of the delays in being able to make that interconnection.

Although Order No. PSC-03-1119-PAA-SU allowed EPS to collect rates prior to the interconnection, EPS is willing to subject those revenues to a potential for a refund, but only after a "true up" of the actual construction costs versus the anticipated construction costs contemplated in that Order.
