The Amelia Island Association (AIA) position on the Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC) proposed rate increase is that it is an unreasonably large increase on Amelia Island residential customers. Therefore, the FPUC Residential Facilities monthly charge and the Residential Service usage charge should be held to the inflation rate, that is a 3% increase.

AIA does not object to the FPUC proposed increase in the residential Initial Entitlement of Service (service connection for new homes or new home owners) proposed rate increase from \$13 to \$44, which is a 238% increase. We recognize that the \$13 charge has probably been too low to cover connection costs and we want to avoid new connection service being subsidized by usage charges.

(This proposed rate increase (Docket No. 030438-EI) is scheduled for a Public Hearing by the Public Service Commission (PSC) on Wed. 12/03/03 at 6:00 PM in the Fernandina Beach City Commissioner Chambers on 204 Ash St. in Fernandina Beach.)

AIA SUPPORTING REASONS

- 1. Monopoly rate increases should be in line with the inflation rate.
- 2. The proposed FPUC rate increase is being communicated as a 17% increase in an average customer's bill. However, this calculation includes the large separate fuel charge (which is \$37.45/1000 kwh or 75% of the total residential usage charge) masking the actual increases in the remaining costs managed by FPUC. The separate fuel charge has been separated by FPUC so that they can pass-through fuel increases to the end customers. The individual rate increases for the costs being managed by FPUC need to be analyzed separately and not masked by the large separate fuel charge which has separate pass-through increases.

- 3. The Residential Usage service charge is proposed by FPUC to increase from \$12.20* per 1000 kwh to \$17.40 per 1000 kwh in 2004. This is a 43% increase, which is significantly greater than the general inflation rate of 3%. The FPUC already has a separate charge for fuel costs that allows for a pass-through of fuel cost increases, in addition to this proposed rate increase. With a utility capital costs are usually more significant and therefore interest rates are an important factor, and we have had the lowest interest rates in decades.
 - *(My Sept. 2003 bill shows an FPUC Usage charge of \$12.70/kwh vs the \$12.20/kwh included in the FPUC rate increase proposal?)
- 4. While FPUC has proposed a 43% increase in the Energy Usage charge for Residential Service they have simultaneously proposed a 33% reduction for General Service Demand (GSD) and a 63% reduction for General Service Large Demand (GLSD). This appears to be an outrageous shift of costs from business to residential customers. In addition, the FPUC provides no explanation for this shift in their proposed rate notice to customers.

- **This energy usage charge is in addition to the separate \$37.45/1000 kwh residential fuel charge.
- 5. The FPUC has also proposed a significant rate reduction in both the Demand charge and the Facilities charge for the General Service Large Demand -1 (GSLD1). The proposed reduction is 20% for both charges. The reason for this reduction is not included in the FPUC customer notice of proposal for rate increases. It is unacceptable to simultaneously reduce business rates while proposing an enormous increase in residential rates without any justification for this cost shift to residential customers.

- 6. The Residential Customer fixed monthly charge is proposed by FPUC to increase from \$7/month to \$10.84/month. This is an increase of 55% compared to the general inflation rate of 3%. The same arguments included in 3 above apply.
- 7. The Customer Entitlement Service Charge (new home owner service connection) is proposed by FPUC to increase from \$13 to \$44, a 238% increase. AIA does not object to this increase since it appears that the current rate is low and has been subsidized by usage rates.
- 8. FPUC states that the overall FPUC proposed increase for an average customer (1000 kwh/month) would be from \$57 to \$66/month for a \$9/month increase. However, this is a \$108/year per home on Amelia Island. With about 10,000 homes on Amelia Island this is a \$1,080,000 increase per year for residents of Amelia Island, and over the next 20 years this "one rate increase" would cost Amelia Island residents \$21,600,000 in increased electricity costs. (This does not include the new connection increase.)
- 9. If the usage and fixed rates were held to 3% the total increase in rates

would be: $\frac{57}{\text{month x .03}} = \frac{50.21}{}$

12.20/1000 kwh x .03 = 0.37

Total increase/month = \$0.58

Total increase/yr = \$6.96/home

Total Amelia Island/yr =\$69,600 Total Amelia Island for 20 yrs = \$1,392,000

Total Amelia Homeowner savings for 20 years by using a 3% rate increase: \$21,600,000 - \$1,400,000 = \$20,200,000.

The Amelia Island Association (AIA) consists of 32 Amelia Island Homeowner Associations that represent 39% of all the homes on Amelia Island.

It would be helpful if FPU would either answer or be prepared to answer the following questions at the forthcoming hearing on rate and charge increases:

What was the percentage change in energy charges for RS and GS granted at the last rate increase?

What is the percent of annual revenue derived from Marianna, from Fernandina Beach, and from elsewhere?

In Fernandina Beach what fraction of total revenue is derived from RS, from GSD, from GSLD1 and from Customer Facilities Charge?

Is it not true that the proposed Service Charges represent a very much larger percentage of the average annual residential billing than of the annual billing of either GS or GSD customers?

Few, if any, would take issue with the need for some electricity rate and charge increases though some might wonder about the effect that the decision to divest water service income had on FPU profitability. However, the size of the proposed increases and their distribution among customer groups needs better explanation.
